Whereas, the Town of Bel Air, the City of Narva in the Republic of Estonia engaged in a Skype signing Sister City Agreement, MOU with the Mayor of Bel Air, the Mayor of Narva Estonia and the US Ambassador to Estonia at the Bel Air Town Hall on April 2nd, 2014; and

Whereas, this Agreement commits the two cities to work together by providing opportunities to discuss plans for future exchanges and cooperation in every field like economy, trade, government; and

Whereas, the mission of the Maryland – Estonia Exchange Council (MEEC) is to advance the friendship of Maryland (MD) and Estonia (EE) by providing opportunities for partnerships that enhance cultural exchanges and strengthen political, economic, medical, educational and security links; and

Whereas, the purpose of MEEC is to establish and coordinate agreements of international cooperation between the towns, cities, counties and governments of EE / MD. These agreements allow specific initiatives for mutual benefit to businesses, cultural exchanges, educational programs, civic organizations, security departments and healthcare institutions; and


in our Sister-City Narva, Estonia and call upon the people of the Town of Bel Air to join our sister-city in celebrating.
